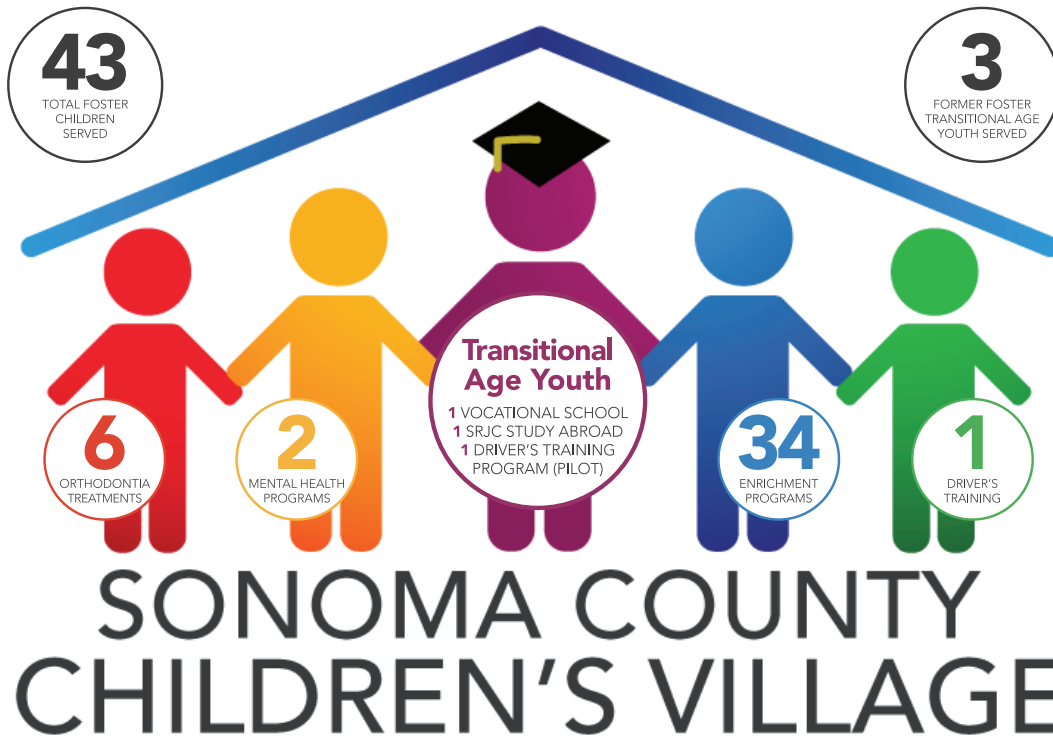


2017 ANNUAL REPORT
